Dear PSR Families,

This letter is in regards to the 2020-2021 PSR year at St. Patrick Church. PLEASE take time to read through this entire letter.

CLASS DAYS AND TIMES

Beginning the week of 4 October 2020, and throughout the Fall of 2020, all non-sacramental preparation grade levels will meet using a hybrid model of both in-person (following CDC guidelines – which includes wearing masks, even if not required by the CDC) as well as virtual instruction. The ordinary gathering times for PSR have been:

- Grades 1–6 Wednesday 4:00 - 5:10 pm
- Grades 7, 8, and Confirmation Classes..... Sunday 9:30 - 10:30 am

The online survey indicated a strong comfort for hybrid as well as in-class instruction. With this in mind, for the remainder of the pandemic, or until directed otherwise by the Diocese of Cleveland or Gov. DeWine, St. Patrick PSR classes will meet as follows:

- Grades 1-3 will attend PSR classes in-person on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of the month.
- Grades 4-6 will attend PSR classes in-person on the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of the month.
- On the off weeks for grades 1-6, there will be virtual instruction.
- Grades 7, 8, and Confirmation class will attend PSR classes in-person weekly.
- All levels of PSR will meet in the church hall

PSR REGISTRATION FORMS

For any student enrolled in the 2019-2020 PSR program at St. Patrick, a pre-printed re-registration form is included with this letter; please correct any error(s), and provide any missing information, on the pre-filled form. Should you wish to enroll an additional child, you will find blank enrollment packets at <https://psr.stpatrick.cc> .

TEMPERATURE

When your child arrives for in-session PSR classes, we'll be taking his/her temperature as s/he enters the building to insure it's below 100°. **We ask you to wait in the parking lot while your child's temperature is being taken** so we don't need to call you to pick them up (should their temperature be elevated).

SANITIZING

After each PSR session, the space used by the students will be sanitized. We have a large quantity of Spray Nine, which is on the list of approved products – and kills the coronavirus within seconds of contact. Tables, chairs, and other frequently-touched surfaces will be given appropriate attention following each PSR session.

TUITION FEES

For registrations received by 9/13/2020 PSR tuition is: \$25 per child. PSR tuition, for those registering after 9/13/2020 is: \$45 per child. To take advantage of the lower tuition, please turn forms and fees in to the church office by Sunday, 13 September 2020. ALL FEES should be REMITTED WITH THIS FORM, but must be remitted no later than the first day of class. As always, if you have any difficulty paying the PSR fee for your child(ren), please contact Fr. Trask so that he may adjust or waive the fees – according to what is most appropriate to your situation.
