The St. Patrick Endowment Trust Scholarship Renewal

This scholarship renewal request is for one year and is not automatically renewed; subsequent renewal requests, with substantiating documentation, are required. If for any reason the scholarship recipient is unable to use the scholarship during the ensuing academic year, the student forfeits his/her right to the funds. The scholarship check will be made payable to the educational institution the student will attend.

Eligibility requirements include:

- Must be an active and participating parishioner of St. Patrick Parish when not away at an institution of higher learning.
- Must actively participate at Mass at the Catholic chapel, Newman Campus Chapel, or in the local parish (adjoining the college) when at the institution of higher learning.
- Must be enrolled in a four-year university or college, a community college, or a vocational school in the United States that was identified in prior scholarship requests.
- Minimum GPA of 2.5

Applicants must submit a complete application (with appropriate Guidance Counselor endorsement); incomplete and/or late submissions will not be considered. Additionally, for those who did not live locally and worship at St. Patrick Parish during the 2020-2021 academic year, a letter from the pastor of the parish (or Newman Catholic Chapel) at which you worshiped is required. Lastly, you'll need two (2) recently written letters of recommendation – one from a professor or counselor who can report your abilities regarding your chosen field of study, and; one from a school administrator, work supervisor, or community leader, who is not a relative, who can attest to your character. All must be submitted **no earlier than 1 February 2021 and no later than 15 March 2021.**

The St. Patrick Endowment Fund Scholarship committee will review all applications and make the final selection(s). Finalists may be called for an interview. Amounts awarded may vary amongst recipients; individual need, intended course-of-study, etc., may serve as factors that influence the amount received. Decisions will be made and recipient(s) will be notified by 30 April 2021.
